

Interoperability Use Case Implementation Plan



Fixed-scope, fixed fee, four weeks. One interoperability use case.

Your organization has decided what it needs to build — a closed-loop social care referral, a care transition notification, gaps in care identification. Now you need the technical details that turn the decision into something a vendor can quote and a funder can approve: which standards and profiles apply, what your current platform can and cannot do today, and the work to be performed fulfil your vision. **In four weeks, Elimu will produce that document for you.**

WHAT YOU RECEIVE

- **Implementation plan.** Use case objectives, current-state analysis of your platform and exchange volumes, applicable standards and profiles, gap analysis, proposed technical approach, effort estimate, and a phased timeline.
- **Vendor requirements document.** Written to be sent directly to your platform vendor, specific enough to function as a procurement instrument.
- **Funding alignment summary.** A mapping of the proposed work to the interoperability language in your state's approved Rural Health Transformation Program initiative.

HOW IT WORKS

1. **You complete a short intake packet.** Current interfaces, transaction volumes, platform, and existing data flows.
2. **The four-week schedule begins.** Elimu confirms the delivery date on receipt of the packet.
3. **Interviews and document review.** Up to ten interviews of forty-five minutes each — typically executive leadership, your technical lead, your program manager, your platform vendor, and clinical or operational end users — alongside review of your participation agreement templates, interface inventory, workflow documentation, and relevant RFP documents.
4. **Live delivery.** The deliverables are presented to your team, with one revision round and a 30-day follow-up call.
